Introduction to the Transfer Housing Selection Guide

This guide assists Transfer students with information related to the housing selection process, including how to complete a housing application, how to form a roommate group, and how the room assignment/confirmation portion of the process works.

All housing selection processes will be completed online through your RESIDENCE account.

Logging Into Your RESIDENCE Account


- If you are a transfer student at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, you must know a few things before logging into RESIDENCE for the first time. To access your new Housing RESIDENCE online account, you need to contact the Office of Residential Life at 870-575-7256 or email reslife@uapb.edu to receive the temporary password for your account. Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM 5:00 PM; located at the Delta Annex Suite 111.
- Please note newly admitted students will have to wait a minimum of 48 hours before they can complete the housing application.
- Once you have received the temporary password, please log in to https://uapb-residence.symplicity.com. Once you have logged in for the first time, the system will prompt you to change your password. Please ensure that your passwords are strong (at least 8 to 10 characters and include number(s)/symbols).


Your Login ID is as follows: You will use the 1st six (6) characters of your last name unless your last name is less than 6 characters, and then use your full last name followed by the 1st character of your first name and the last four digits of your *Student Id number*.

Please see example:

- Your name is William Smith and your ID number is 0009999 then your login id would be **smithw9999@uapb.edu**.
- Please note newly admitted students will have to wait a minimum of 48 hours before they can complete the housing application.
- Please note that newly admitted students will have to wait a minimum of 48 hours after submitting the housing application and deposit before you can access the RESIDENCE system.
