Policy: RELATIONS WITH LEGISLATORS AND ELECTED OFFICIALS

Policy #: **7.12**

As a citizen, you have the right to exercise freedom of expression on legislative matters. However, you should not, unless authorized, attempt to speak on behalf of the University in discussions with members of the Arkansas General Assembly, Arkansas constitutional officers, members of Congress, or local and county elected officials.

You have the right to communicate with elected officials concerning matters related to your job, and cannot be subjected to discipline, reprimands, or notations in your personnel file because you exercised that right. However, if you intentionally make untrue allegations to an elected official concerning matters related to your job, you may be subject to discipline.
