

PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER (Police Officer)

The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff is accepting applications to fill the position of **Public Safety Officer**. The **Public Safety Officer (Police Officer)** will perform law enforcement duties that provide for the safety and security of the University Community. These duties include, but are not limited to: patrol and law enforcement activities, enforcing state and local laws and University regulations and physical security activities; must be able to work rotating shifts (3-shifts over a 24 hour period) and days off with routine overtime requirements; occasional work in extreme weather conditions at times; performs daily maintenance and equipment checks on patrol unit and maintains a professional appearance through upkeep and maintenance of uniform, duty equipment and personal grooming; appears in court to testify; serves as a resource for visitors, students, staff and faculty, and directs them to appropriate offices, agencies and organizations to deal with problems; performs other assigned or needed duties relative to the operations of the Department of Public Safety. **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** *Must be at least 21 Years of age with education equivalent of a high school diploma, must be a citizen of the United State; must possess a valid Arkansas Driver License; must be able to pass a comprehensive personal and criminal history background investigation; must meet the minimum physical and employment requirements as a law enforcement officer. Must not have either entered a plea of guilty or been convicted of a Felony, or Domestic Violence Offense. PERFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: ALETA Certified Law Enforcement Officers, Part-Time I, or Part-Time II.*
