****Articulation Requirements:**

According to the Arkansas Articulation Model, the LPN/LPTN student articulates 8 credit hours (Introduction to Nursing/Critical Thinking and Adult Health Nursing Care I) upon admission into the nursing program.

The LPN/LPTN must complete 61 hours in the major prior to graduation.

No competency testing or work experience required if <12 months after graduation.

No competency testing required if work experience (at least 1000 hours) is documented for the past 24 months.

Competency testing may be required if >60 months since graduation.

LPN/LPTN TO BSN COMPLETION TRACK

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants who are licensed as Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) or Licensed Psychiatric Technician Nurse (LPTN) through an ADN or Diploma program are eligible to apply for advanced placement admission to the upper division.

The applicant:

- A. Must submit to the University a formal application and all supporting materials; including official and current transcripts or GED test scores, ACT or SAT test scores, and immunization records to the Office of Admissions and Academic Records by the appropriate deadline.
- B. Must submit a completed nursing program application by the appropriate deadline.
- C. Must be a graduate of a licensed practical program which was NLNAC accredited at the time of graduation
- D. Should have graduated from nursing school 12-60 months prior to entering the BSN program.
- E. Must submit an employee verification letter as part of their admission packet.
- F. Must submit a copy of a current, unencumbered LPN/LPTN license for placement on file in the nursing office (updated appropriately).
- G. Must enroll in and successfully complete the following nursing transition courses as prerequisite to advanced placement to the Upper Divisions:
 1. NURS 3302 Transitions to Professional Nursing
 2. NURS 2302 Pathophysiology
 3. NURS 2303 Basic Pharmacology in Nursing Practice
- H. May be awarded credits equivalent to at least 8, and no more than 38, semester credit hours in nursing through articulation or testing.

The LPN/LPTN completes all prerequisite course work as outlined for the freshman and sophomore years in the nursing curriculum. Credits for the following courses is achieved through articulation and/or testing (CLEP):

NURS 2301 Introduction to Nursing and Critical thinking
NURS 2506 Adult Health I

The applicant then enters the nursing program in the fall semester junior year. In the absence of active employment, as stipulated in the Arkansas Nursing Articulation Model, LPNs/LPTNs may be required to take a placement examination to challenge prerequisite courses.

Information concerning examination dates, study guides, and making payments can be secured from the Department of Nursing Office. The student is responsible for the cost of the examinations.
