According to the Arkansas Articulation Model, the  
RN Student articulates the

Introduction to Nursing and Critical Thinking  
Adult Health I  
Adult Health II  
Psychiatric/Mental Health  
Caring for the Childbearing Family  
Pediatric and Child Health Nursing Care

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The RN must complete 37 hours in the major  
prior to graduation.

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No competency testing or work experience is re-  
quired if <12 months after graduation.

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No competency testing required if work experi-  
ence (at least 1000 hours) is documented for the  
past 24 months.

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Competency testing may be required if >60  
months since graduation.

## **RN-BSN COMPLETION PROGRAM ADVANCED PLACEMENT**

To facilitate the educational mobility of licensed nurses, the Department awards credit for advanced placement of students licensed as RNs through the Nursing Articulation Model. Licensed students must meet the program admission requirements, be a graduate of ASBN/NLN approved program and have a valid and current nursing license. Test requirements are consistent with the Arkansas Articulation Model. Applicants who are licensed as Registered Nurses (RN) through an ADN or Diploma program are eligible to apply for advanced placement admission to the upper division.

The applicant:

- A. Must be a graduate of an associated degree or diploma program which was NLN accredited at the time of graduation;
- B. Must enroll in and successfully complete the transition course Transitions to Professional Nursing (NURS3302), Pathophysiology (NURS2302), Evidenced Based Practice in Nursing Research (NURS3305), and Pharmacology in Nursing Practice (NURS2303) as pre-requisite to advanced placement in upper division nursing;
- C. Must be awarded credits equivalent to at least 33, and no more than 38, semester credit hours in nursing through articulation;
- D. Should have graduated from nursing school 12-60 months prior to entering the BSN program.
- E. Must submit the employee verification letter as part of their admission packet.
- F. Must submit a copy of a current, unencumbered RN license for placement on file in the nursing office (updated appropriately).

The RN completes all prerequisite course work as outlined for the freshman, sophomore, and junior years in the nursing curriculum. Credit for NURS2310 Introduction to Nursing Care, NURS2506 Adult Health I, NURS3500 Adult Health II, NURS3502 Caring for the Childbearing Family, and NURS3503 Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing Care is achieved by articulation and/or testing (see below). The applicant then enters the nursing program in the fall semester, senior year, after successfully completing all prerequisites including NURS3302 Transitions to Professional Nursing, NURS2303 Basic Pharmacology in Nursing Practice, N2302 Pathophysiology, and NURS3305 Evidenced Based Practices in Nursing Research .

In the absence of active employment, as stipulated in the Arkansas Nursing Articulation Model, unemployed RNs may be required to take a placement examinations to challenge the following nursing courses:

The NLN ACEI examinations are administered by the Department of Nursing, Information concerning examination dates, study guides, and making payments can be secured from the Department of Nursing office. The student is responsible for the cost of the examinations.
