The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff is conducting a search to fill the position of Project Specialist/Athletic Trainer in the Department of Intercollegiate Athletics. The Project Specialist/Athletic Trainer should possess the knowledge and techniques needed to diagnose, treat, and rehabilitate injured athletes; conduct initial assessments of the injuries or illnesses to provide emergency or continued care. Provide care for athletic injuries using physical therapy equipment, techniques, and medication; evaluate athletes' readiness to play and provide clearances from participation when necessary and warranted; assess and report the progress of recovering athletes to coaches and physicians; advise athletes on the proper use of equipment; collaborate with physicians to develop and implement comprehensive rehabilitation programs for athletic injuries; develop training programs and routines designed to improve athletic performance. **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's degree, Master's Degree preferred, one to three years of relevant experience as an project specialist/athletic trainer or in related area.
