ASSISTANT PROFESSOR/ COORDINATOR (Mathematics - tenure track)

The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff (UAPB) is a multi-cultural, state supported land grant university located in the beautiful and scenic south-central Arkansas. UAPB possesses unique strengths, opportunities and challenges as the second oldest public institution in the state of Arkansas and the oldest with a black heritage. Founded in 1873 as Branch Normal College, it has a rich history and is now part of the University of Arkansas system. The university offers undergraduate and graduate degrees in various fields of study.

The Department of Mathematical Sciences and Technology is seeking to fill the position of Assistant Professor/Coordinator. In addition to a commitment to teaching classes, the faculty member is expected to give University service, advise/mentor students, work on curriculum modification /enhancement for undergraduate and graduate students, and participate in developing partnerships and /or collaboration in Departmental disciplines, proposal writing, and maintain a program of scholarly activities.

It is desired that the position is filled by an individual with expertise in Mathematics Education and/or Applied Mathematics/Statistics with a specialization in algebra, analysis and or statistics. All candidates should have experience using technology such as graphing calculators, statistics software and computer algebra systems in the classroom. **Responsibilities** include teaching up to twelve (12) semester hours of courses per semester.

Qualifications for positions: an earned Ph.D. degree in Applied or Pure Mathematics/Statistics required an earned Ph.D. degree in Computer Science preferred and/or master's degree required an earned Ph.D. degree in Industrial Technology or related field preferred and/or master's degree required. Applicant must provide evidence of being capable and willing to do research. The applicant must demonstrate excellent interpersonal and communication skills. Special consideration will be given to applicant who meets the qualifications and has at least five (5) years of experience in teaching college-level Mathematics in the United States, and has participated in collaborative research and grant writing.

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until position is filled.
