

COACH OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff is conducting a search to fill the position of Offensive Coordinator in the Department of Intercollegiate Athletics. The Coordinator should have the skills and abilities to assist the Head Football Coach in properly planning, development, administering, and evaluating the total operation of the Football Program. This includes, but is not limited to, team performance, supporting the academic achievement of student athletes, recruiting, program management (eligibility certification, event management, scheduling, travel planning, budget management, equipment, athletic training, etc.), college and community service, supervision of assistant offensive coaches and program personnel.
