

Faculty Search School Of Education

The Department of Curriculum and Instruction in the School of Education at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff is seeking applications and nominations for a 9 month, tenure-track position as an Assistant/Associate Professor in Early Childhood Education.

The University: The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff is a member of the University of Arkansas system located 38 miles southeast of the State Capitol, Little Rock, Arkansas. The University is a four year land grant institution. For more information see <http://www.uapb.edu/>.

The School of Education: The School of Education offers programs that are accredited by the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) and approved by the Arkansas Department of Higher Education. The Department of Curriculum and Instruction offers undergraduate and graduate studies in Early Childhood (P-4); Middle Level Language Arts and Social Studies (6-8); Middle Level Math and science (6-8) and Secondary Education; Masters in Early Childhood and Secondary Education and a Masters of Arts in Teaching.

The Position: The successful applicant will be responsible for teaching graduate and undergraduate courses, establishing and maintaining school partnerships, student advisement, student teachers/Interns, community services and continuing professional development. Knowledge of ECE and NCATE accreditation and the use of technology are required.

Qualifications: Applicants must have an earned doctorate in Early Childhood or a related field; ABD considered. Applicants must submit evidence of three years of relevant licensed public school teaching in an early childhood licensure area, pre-K to grade 4 in at least two different grade levels; evidence of eligibility to receive an Arkansas Teaching License in Early Childhood; evidence of research interest and skills in publications in peer reviewed journals and grant writing; evidence of experience with balanced literacy programs; and evidence of interest in the integration of technology with the curriculum.

Appointment and Salary: The salary will be commensurate with experience and qualifications. The position will be available August 2011.

Application Deadline: The Search Committee will begin reviewing applications May 1, 2011 and will continue to do so until the position is filled.
