

ATHLETIC TRAINER

The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff is conducting a search to fill the position of Athletic Trainer in the Department of Intercollegiate Athletics. The Project Athletic Trainer should possess the knowledge and techniques needed to diagnose, treat, and rehabilitate injured athletes; conduct initial assessments of the injuries or illnesses to provide emergency or continued care. Provide care for athletic injuries using physical therapy equipment, techniques, and medication; evaluate athletes' readiness to play and provide clearances from participation when necessary and warranted; assess and report the progress of recovering athletes to coaches and physicians; advise athletes on the proper use of equipment; collaborate with physicians to develop and implement comprehensive rehabilitation programs for athletic injuries; develop training programs and routines designed to improve athletic performance. **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's degree, Master's Degree preferred, two to three years of relevant experience as an athletic trainer.

CERTIFICATION: Must be certified by the BOC and have ATC, LAT or eligible for Arkansas Licensing.
