The individual will be expected to establish a competitive research program involving undergraduate students.

A biologist with the expertise to teach courses in histology, physiology and freshman level biology for majors and non-majors is desired. A Ph.D. in biological sciences or a related area is required.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications. Position must be filled by January 3, 2012.
