

## **UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT PINE BLUFF**

### **Fire Report 2009-2010**

June 5, 2012

The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff maintains six (6) on-campus housing facilities: The Delta Housing Complex is equipped with a sprinkler system, alarm and fire extinguishers on each floor; Douglas Hall, Harrold Complex, Hunt Hall, Johnny B. Johnson Housing Complex and Lewis Hall are equipped with an alarm system and fire extinguisher on each floor.

There were six fire drills scheduled during the 2009-2012 Academic Years. The following UL-approved electrical appliances that are authorized for use in residence hall rooms according to the university policies/rules on electrical appliances, smoking and open flames in on-campus housing facilities are: radios, televisions, sewing machines, study lamps, stereo equipment, videocassette recorders, shavers, coffee pots, typewriters, computers, clocks, irons, fans, electric blankets, heating pads, hair curlers, electric toothbrushes, humidifiers and calculators. Other cooking appliances, toaster ovens, open heating coils appliances, sunlamps and electrical heaters are unacceptable due to fire hazard associated with these appliances.

Smoking is prohibited in all residence halls. In the event the fire alarm sounds the procedure for evacuation is as follows: Everyone must vacate the building immediately using the nearest stairway exit, but dress in preparation for exiting outdoors (shoe, coat, etc.) Residents should not return to the building until the signal "all is clear" is given by University Police or the Local Fire Department personnel.

The Resident Specialist assigned to each residence hall must report on the Morning Report Form that a fire occurred. A copy of this report must be sent to the Associate Dean of Students for Residential Life and an Incident Report to the Campus Police Department.

There were no reported fires, deaths, property damages, injuries or treatments related to fires during the 2009-2012 Academic Years.
