

This announcement is being published to provide important information to the campus community regarding the transition and official acceptance of the ***“MyUAPB Card”***. Effective, August 15, 2012, the ***“MyUAPB Card”*** will be the ONLY official campus picture identification card accepted. **This applies to all cards issued prior to July 9, 2012, including previously issued “MyUAPB Cards”**. Students are highly encouraged to obtain a current ***“MyUAPB Card”*** to ensure their continued access to campus activities, designated facilities, events, and other campus services. All previously issued Campus ID Cards will be **disabled** and the following services **denied**.

- **Access to Campus Dining Halls**
- **Access to all Athletics Events such as football games, basketball games, baseball games, soccer games, volleyball games, and etc.**
- **Bookstore Purchases**
- **Library Services**
- **Access to Resident Halls**
- **Access to card swipe controlled facilities**
- **Official Identification for admittance to take required tests**
- **Controlled access to specific locations around campus**

The ***“MyUAPB Card”*** is currently available at the Department of Public Safety Traffic Office, and can be obtained at this time by students attending the Summer II Semester Session. To obtain the ***“MyUAPB Card”***, Students must provide a registration printout to verify current enrollment and turn in their old ID Card. There is no CHARGE for this service. If students are unable to provide their old ID card, due to it being lost or stolen, a **\$15.00 replacement fee** will apply.

Students who have **pre-registered for the fall 2012 semester** may obtain their ***“MyUAPB Card”*** beginning the week of August 15, 2012.

Faculty and Staff will not be issued new cards at this time, due to current card stock. They will be notified when additional cards are available.

Students who do not obtain the current (issued on and after July 9, 2012) ***“MyUAPB Card”*** will be denied all campus services and activities as described above in the bullet section of this announcement. It is your responsibility to obtain the **Official *“MyUAPB Card”***.
