

**1.3.e Key assessments and scoring guides used for assessing professional dispositions, including fairness and the belief that all students can learn**

The School of Education measures dispositions in at various stages of as the student matriculates through the teacher education program. There are two faculty evaluations and two interview evaluations. The faculty evaluation or recommendation accompanies the application to the School of Education Admission and another will accompany the School of Education Professional Semester application. There are two interviews for each student at the Admission to School of Education and Admission to Professional Semester. If a student does not meet the minimum requirements, the chair of his/her department and education advisor is notified to address the areas of concerns.
