The initial programs require cooperating teachers for the professional semesters are licensed in the area in which the candidate is seeking licensure placement. Cooperating teachers must possess a valid teaching certification for current teaching assignment, have a minimum of three (3) years teaching experience, have the support of the building supervisor/administrator to host a candidate, possess a philosophy that is consistent with that of the program, understand all roles and responsibilities, and willing to participate in the role as cooperating teacher.
