

Profile: Rebecca Lochmann is a Professor of Aquaculture/Fish Nutrition at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, and has served as Interim Chair/Center Director for Aquaculture and Fisheries since July 2015. She received her Ph.D. at Texas A&M University in Wildlife and Fisheries Science. Research focuses on nutrient requirements, alternative feed ingredients, feeding regimes, and the interactions between diet and fish health, reproduction, stress physiology, and sensory properties of fish products. Rebecca is Immediate Past President of the World Aquaculture Society, and a Past-President of the US Chapter of the World Aquaculture Society, and the Central Arkansas Chapter of Sigma Xi.
