- ACT and/or SAT scores (UAPB Federal school code: 001086)
- Official and final high school or GED transcripts; Transfer students must submit transcripts from all Colleges/Universities attended.
- Current immunization record with proof of immunity against measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) for students born after 1957 before registration at Arkansas colleges and universities.

Transfer Students

A transfer student with more than 30 semester hours with a "C" average or better must submit an application for admission and an official transcript from all institutions previously attended. Transfer students with fewer than 30 semester hours of credit must submit an application for admission, high school transcript, ACT or SAT scores and all college/university transcripts, and immunization records including two separate MMR vaccinations within 6-weeks of each other. Transfer students with less than a "C" average from colleges or other universities may be admitted to the University on academic probation with the approval of the Admissions Appeals Committee. Transfer students asked to withdraw from other institutions for academic reasons will not be allowed to enroll at the University until they are eligible for re-enrollment at the institutions previously attended. Students from other colleges and universities who desire to attend the University during the summer only may be admitted by submitting an application and a statement of good standing from the institution where they are regularly enrolled. If a student becomes a degree candidate, all admissions requirements must be met.

FULL ADMISSION

- Completed the high school core curriculum
- An ACT score of 19 or above or SAT score of 910 or above
- Score of 43 or above on the ASSET Reading Test or 62 or above on the COMPASS Reading test
- A high school GPA of 2.00 or above

CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

- An ACT score of 15-18 OR SAT exam equivalent
- A high school GPA of 2.00 or above
