ASSOCIATE ATHLETICS TRAINER/HPER INSTRUCTOR

The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, an NCAA Division I (FCS) member of the NCAA and Southwestern Athletic Conference, invites applications for the position of Associate Athletics Trainer/HPER Instructor. This position, which will have dual reporting to the Head Athletics Trainer and the HPER Department Chair, is responsible for the prevention, evaluation, treatment, referral and rehabilitation of injuries/illnesses to student-athletes. This position will also teach classes in the HPER Department and provide student-athlete welfare seminars. Specific duties include, but are not limited to: the daily health care of student-athletes; recording and maintaining appropriate medical records for treatment given; interfacing with various internal and external personnel for referral purposes and information exchange; processing medical bills and requisitions for payment; coordinating physical examinations; supervising a staff which may consist of graduate and undergraduate student assistants; and other duties as assigned by the Director of Athletics. A master's degree is preferred; a minimum of a Bachelor's degree is required. NATA and CPR/AED certification is required. Candidates must be eligible for licensing as an Athletics Trainer in the State of Arkansas.
