The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, an NCAA Division I (FCS) member of the NCAA and Southwestern Athletic Conference, invites applicants for the position of Strength and Conditioning Coach. This position, which reports directly to the Director of Athletics, is responsible for implementing, conducting and monitoring strength and conditioning for the university's eight men's and eight women's sports program. Duties and responsibilities include, but not are limited to, designing, implementing, conducting and monitoring strength and conditioning programs for 16 Division I sports program; coordinating student-athlete rehabilitation with athletics training staff and assisting with rehabilitation of injured student-athletes; helping to educate student-athletes about nutrition and supplementation; assisting with coordinating, maintenance and staff of weight room/strength facilities, assisting in identifying and purchasing needed strength and conditioning equipment and assisting in scheduling weight room training for the various sports programs; and training and supervising interns and graduate assistants.

Minimum Qualifications: A bachelor's degree is required (master's preferred) with at least two years of related experience; must be first aid, AED and CPR certified; must meet all licensing requirements as required by the NCAA, including certification by the National Strength and Conditioning Association; must have a working knowledge of medical terminology.
