## 1.2 TYPE OF CONTRACT

- A. As a result of this RFP, the Department intends to award a contract to a single contractor.
- B. Term Dates. The original term (Original Term) of the Contract shall commence on May 1, 2024, and shall continue until April 30, 2028, unless earlier terminated or cancelled in accordance with the Contract or some other writing agreed to and signed by the parties, but in no event may the Original Term exceed a period of four (4) consecutive years from the effective date of the Original Term, unless exempt from Ark. Code Ann. § 19-11-238(c)(1). By written agreement of the parties, the term of the Contract may be extended or renewed for additional time beyond the Original Term. This allows for a total possible term (Total Possible Term) beyond the Contract's Original Term, as defined in the following paragraph.
- **C.** The initial term of a resulting contract will be for one (1) year. Upon mutual agreement by the Contractor and Department, the contract may be renewed by UAPB for up to six (6) additional one-year terms or portions thereof, not to exceed a total aggregate contract term of seven (7) consecutive years.
- A. This initial contract will be for 1 year as long as both parties agree, we will extend up to (7) years afterward.
  - **A.** As a result of this RFP, the Department intends to award a contract to a single contractor.
  - **B.** The anticipated starting date for any resulting contract is <u>May 1, 2024</u>, except that the actual contract date may be adjusted forward unilaterally by the State for up to three months. By submitting a signed proposal in response to the RFP, the Prospective Contractor represents and warrants that it will honor its proposal as being held open as irrevocable for this period.
  - **C.** The initial term of a resulting contract will be for one (1) year. Upon mutual agreement by the Contractor and Department, the contract may be renewed by UAPB for up to **three (3)** additional one-year terms or portions thereof, not to exceed six (6) additional one-year terms or portions thereof, not to exceed a total aggregate contract term of seven (7) consecutive years.
