Upon completion, students will be able to understand and use simple Chinese phrases, meet basic needs for communication and possess the ability to further your Chinese language studies.

You will learn:

- More than 150 commonly used words;
- Around 20 key grammar points;
- Fun facts about China

At the end of the course, should you meet certain criteria, you will be awarded with a certificate. You will also be required to give a presentation in Chinese on the final lesson.

Requirements

Students should have access to a webcam and microphone as classes will be conducted online via Zoom.

Students are expected to attend 90% of the lessons.
