This proposal is to adopt a \$30.00 per credit hour 'Upcharge Nursing Departmental Fee" for all courses with the NURS prefix in addition to the current Nursing Test Fee and other University fees. The purpose of the requested Departmental Fee is to provide a method of upfront payment to cover increasing costs associated with specialized nursing assessment programs, nursing technology and specialized medical lab supplies, required clinical screenings, and malpractice insurance.

All BSN programs in the state of Arkansas are contracted for services to provide integrated testing and/or assessments throughout the curriculum. Data is available to support a correlation between assessment support services and student success on the NCLEX-RN. The current service being used at UAPB is Kaplan. Only one (1) other BSN program contracts with Kaplan for these services and reports little or no correlation in terms of predicting student success. The current Kaplan contract expires 8/5/2017. The Department will begin using a different vendor which will increase the amount that students will be required to pay for testing and assessment. Without the Departmental Fee, students will be required to pay for this increase and other program expenses out of pocket at various points in the program.

To offset the cost of this assessment service and the additional program expenses, most Nursing programs assess a per/credit hour and/or a per course fee to students enrolled in the clinical program.
